

APOLLO BAY ART SHOW

Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully before submitting artwork

1. The 48th Art Show is for the display and sale of original and new artworks. Works can include painting, drawing, printmaking, mixed media, textile, 3D sculpture, jewellery and photography. All artworks entered are to be for sale.
2. Artists entering must be a minimum 16 years of age.
3. **Entry Fees: \$10.00 for each artwork.**
4. **Exhibitors may enter up to three (3) artworks. Maximum size of work is 100cm x 100cm including frame. No work should exceed 10kg. Pairs/diptych will be considered as two works. Space is limited so works larger than 100cm are at the discretion of the committee.** Please discuss with Kelly Murphy 0449 803 865 or apollobayartshow@gmail.com
5. Entry fees are non-refundable.
6. All artwork must be the artist's original work and not previously entered at the Apollo Bay Art Show i.e. not reproduction or prints of own or another artist's work, or in breach of copyright. The work/s must be the product and property of the exhibiting artist and signed by the artist.
7. **ENTRIES CLOSE: 5pm on SUNDAY 16TH MARCH 2025.** Late entries will not be accepted.
8. All works (except sculpture) must be soundly mounted in a professionally acceptable manner. Please ensure that the wire/cord is FIRMLY attached and strong enough to support the piece. Artwork will not be hung if not secure. 3D sculpture works need to be stable and freestanding. Jewellery pieces need to be enclosed in a safe display box.
9. The back, or base, of each artwork must include: the title, artist's name and price (as submitted on the entry form). If multiple works of one concept are submitted or multiple "untitled" works are submitted, each must be prefixed with a unique number. i.e. "1 Untitled", "2 Untitled" / "1 Cape Patton", "2 Cape Patton".
10. Artworks are exhibited at the artist's own risk. The Apollo Bay Art Show Committee takes reasonable steps to protect the works in their care but accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of exhibited works. It is the artist's responsibility to insure their own works if required.
11. The Apollo Bay Art Show Committee reserves the right to hang or display a lesser number of works entered by any artist if space is limited.
12. The Apollo Bay Art Show Committee reserves the right to refuse work for exhibition. Wet entries will not be accepted. Reproductions or prints of original works will not be accepted. Any works that do not comply with the Conditions of Entry will not be exhibited. The decision of the committee is final.
13. **Sale of Exhibits:** The Apollo Bay Art Show Committee will charge a **20% commission** on the sale of each artwork. Please take this into account when setting your selling price. Sale prices will not be negotiated with buyers. Prices given at time of entry are final.
14. No amendments will be made to entry information after the deadline Sunday 16 MARCH 2025
15. When completing your on-line entry form please note that a red * denotes a mandatory field. Fields without this mark are filled at your discretion (i.e. images for each submission).
